Please E-mail or call us a week or so before your arrival date to discuss the keys and in case of any last minute questions you may have.

Please remember to bring towels and paper towels.

Take the Maine turnpike north to exit 63 (Gray).
After the toll booth take the route 26 Gray bypass by turning left at the lights, cross over the turnpike and then take the next right.
Then take Route 26 north the whole way. It is approximately 1 hour and fifteen minutes from the exit to the house.

You will pass through towns such as Mechanic Falls, Poland, Oxford (you will see Wal-mart on the left), Norway (Hannaford's supermarket on the right), South Paris (you will cross the railroad tracks) then West Paris where you will cross route 219 and there is a Mobil station on the left and Perham's fine jewelry store is on the right. You are now about 15 minutes from the house.

As you approach Bryant pond, you will see route 232 diverge to the right (stay on 26) and you will then descend a long, steep hill. At the bottom, 26 curves sharply to the right. You then pass "Breaus too" store on the left. Make note of this store. Quick access from the house and they have a good breakfast and serve pizza, subs etc. If you look just beyond the store you will see our Bryant Pond station house over by the lake.

In about a mile you will pass a ball field on the left and in another 1 mile you should see a white Walker mower service center sign on the right. Go another $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile or so and after descending a small hill, you will pass Littlefield beach campground on the left and there is a lake immediately on your right. Then you will pass a brown house on the left, start slowing down and put your left blinker on.

Marshall lane is just ahead on the left. It is almost opposite Johnny's bridge road on the right. Turn left onto Marshall. Note: This is a private, dirt road so drive slowly.

Note: if you come into the village of Locke mills you missed the turn.

In about 50 yards VERY CAREFULLY cross the ACTIVE RAILROAD TRACKS and take your second right.
Note: Frequently the first right is not plowed in the winter.
The second right is our driveway. The first thing you will see is our vintage railroad caboosel!
Beyond the caboosel are the buildings that make up Round pond station. We refer to the main house as the "Station" and the second building as the "Roundhouse". The small building beyond the hot tub is the "Shanty" or to some, the luv-shak.

Please respect the neighbors and tone down any outdoor activities by 10:00 PM.
